

Terms & Conditions

Terms

- Payments to be made the day of the sale before the horse leaves the ranch. All sales are for cash unless other arrangements have been made prior to the sale with the Southern Alberta Livestock Exchange Ltd. Personalized cheques will be considered as cash.
- Bidding will be in terms of Canadian Funds: thus US buyers can adjust to the current exchange rate which will be posted on the day of the sale.
- US Buyers will take delivery of any purchases once all funds have been cleared.

Registration Papers

- All horses are registered and will be sold as such. Transfer of registration will be completed by the seller. Each buyer will require current membership of the AQHA before transfer of registration papers is complete.
- Registration transfer will be completed once all funds are clear.

Responsibility & Expenses

- The buyer will assume responsibility and expenses for a horse after the fall of the Auctioneer's gavel. Feed and water will be available at a cost to the buyer. All horses that are purchased by buyers for outside of Canada must make arrangements with Willow Spring Ranch to board the horses until payment has cleared for a fee of \$10.00 plus GST per day.
- All horses that are to stay on the Willow Spring Ranch after the sale must have insurance, which can be purchased the day of the sale from Hartford Insurance at the buyer's expense.
- There will be 5% GST added to the selling price of all horses sold.

Liabilities

- Any person attending the sale does so at his or her own risk. The sellers, sales committee, sale personnel and attendants assume no liability, legal or otherwise, for any accidents that occur.
- The Sellers, Sales Committee, Sale Personnel and Editors will not be held responsible for errors or omissions that may inadvertently appear in the Catalog, Posters or WebSite.

Offsite Bidders

- Bids may be accepted from the Internet Direct Livestock Marketing System Ltd. (www.dlms.ca) or by phone the day of the sale.
- The auctioneer has complete charge of the sale, and in case of a dispute in bidding, his decisions is final.
